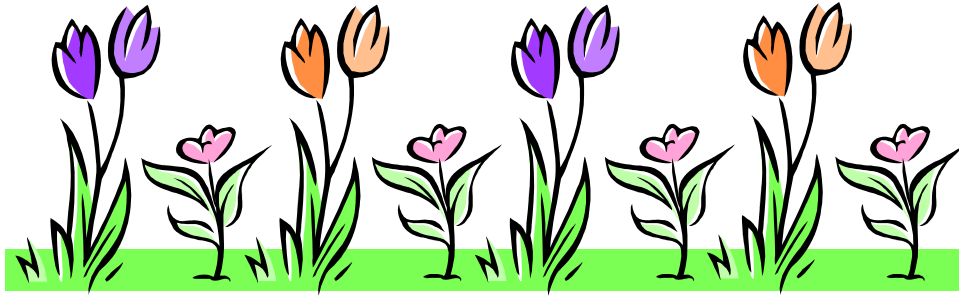
CASH ONLY/NO CHECKS TO "CASH": Please put all cash in a LABELED/SEALED Envelope.
